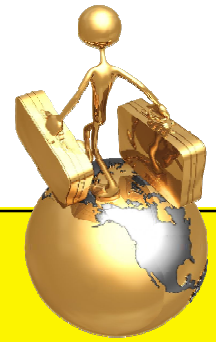

The parish church of Ayr was dedicated to John the Baptist (indeed, the town was known for many years as St John's Town of Ayr) and grew to become a most impressive building with many additions. This then underlines the historic credentials of the town, but more is to be found as you wander round this surprisingly vibrant, healthy yet ancient of places.
