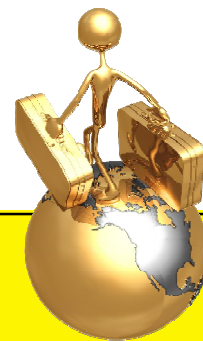

All this on the doorstep, and, the beautiful surrounding scenery of the Lake District and Yorkshire Dales; both of which we will be visiting during our stay.
